



## FACT SHEET: EHU PRESS

Founded in Minsk in 1995, the European Humanities University (EHU) Press was established to provide the University students with a wide range of knowledge in the contemporary humanities and give specialists an opportunity to share their findings.

The publications often impart unique perspectives and approaches gleaned by scholars who live the realities of social transformation processes and study the implications from the vantage of intercultural exchange. Priority is given to studies and translations in the fields of philosophy, psychology, fine arts, linguistics, literature studies, economics, law, and religion studies, among others.

The EHU press publishes in Belarusian, Russian, English, French, and German languages. Publications registered in international databases include:

### *TOPOS*

The multilingual journal *Topos* has been published since 2000. It explores the intersection of philosophy and cultural studies combining different theoretical and methodological perspectives of various topical issues in the humanities, social and cultural sciences. The journal is a part of The Philosopher's Index international database.

### *BELARUSIAN HISTORICAL REVIEW*

The journal was founded in 1994 as an alternative to existing scientific publications in the fields of Belarusian history, historiography and methodology of historical research. The Review publishes historical sources and materials, articles on Belarusian history, essays on historiography and other aspects of historical science, interviews, discussions, book-reviews and information about the scientific inquiry in Belarus and Europe.

### *CROSSROADS*

The scholarly journal has been published by the Center for Advanced Studies and Education since 2004 to provide a multi-disciplinary research approach dedicated to the political and socio-cultural issues of the Central Eastern European borderlands.
