bold, size: 14, center alignment

Full name of the author and information (academic degree, academic title (if any), position, educational institution, place of work in case of graduation; city in which it is located, state).

bold font, size: 14, left alignment, no more than 3 authors are allowed;

The applicant for higher education must also indicate the level of higher education (first, second, third) and information about the supervisor
