

1. Individual research (art) activity packages



Individual research (art) activity packages can be used to cover/implement following activities:

- Publishing of scientific articles/books and other research/art results.
- Translation of the materials and proofreading done by native speakers.
- Participation in the conferences.
- Art projects and participation in the events of professional art.
- EHU-related research (art) dissemination activities.
- Membership fees in associations.

Other types of research, art, development activities, which meet the strategic goals of the University.

2. Science (art) publications publishing fund

The funds are allocated for publishing scientific monographs, studies, collections of articles, textbooks, or teaching materials, as well as art publications. Only publications included in the University's publishing plan are financed by the fund.



3. Scientific Travel Fund



The fund is designated for EHU academic staff to participate in scientific (artistic) trips: conferences, professional development courses, art events, libraries, research internships, symposiums, etc. When embarking on a scientific (artistic) trip, it is necessary to follow the current EHU staff scientific travel regulations.

4. EHU Development Fund

The aim of the Fund is to ensure purposeful distribution of funding for the implementation of the research (art) activity and by this to promote development of research and development at the University. An application to Fund is an instrument for the EHU individual researchers (and /or artists) and their groups to deliver a concrete idea and display its implementation procedures in order to base its eligibility for the financial support from the University's financial resources.



5. Support from the Lithuanian Research Council to publish scientific articles and release books

Books supported for publication must be published by high-level international publishers that also publish scholarly works.

Scientific articles, which publication is supported, must meet the following requirements:

- Scientific articles in the field of humanities must be published in high-level internationally peer-reviewed (periodical, serial, or standalone) scholarly journals.
- Scientific articles in the field of social sciences must be published in foreign scholarly journals with an Impact Factor (IF) in the Clarivate Analytics Web of Science or SCOPUS databases, or in other internationally peer-reviewed (periodical, serial, or standalone) scholarly journals published abroad.
